

Classification of bed specialities

Bed specialities are determined by the health care services offered in relation with particular inpatient beds. These specialities are set by the laws that regulate national health care system.

Current classification of bed specialities was enforced on the 1st of January 2013. This bases on the Estonian eHealth Foundation classification. Below, there is a transition table for current and previous version of the classifications.
